## **Program:**

The World Languages Program (WLP) is a tuition-based, extra-curricular enrichment activity offered at many D97 schools. At Beye it is offered for all grades, including Kindergarten. WLP teachers expose your child to Spanish, German, French, and Mandarin (Chinese) through games, songs, and classroom discussions. WLP supplements Beye's in-curricular Spanish program and provides instruction in other languages. WLP is administered by the Beye PTO through parent volunteers who serve on the WLP committee. ## **Teachers:**

**French** Orly Slobodkin has a master's degree in French literature from the Sorbonne in Paris and teaches French using the method of "total physical response."

**German** Lisa Peters returns as German teacher. She has taught at Beye and at various PTO sponsored language programs for many years.

**Mandarin (Chinese)** Hai Tao Huang has a degree in music performance and teaches music theory and trumpet at UIC. He has taught Mandarin Chinese at Lincoln School for the past two and one half years. His classes focus on reading, writing, speaking and listening.

**Practical Arts Spanish Immersion** Olga Callupe from Peru will teach immersion Spanish based on manual and practical arts. She has an affiliation with John Cabral and Espanol Del Juan. She has taught Spanish at various schools in the Oak Park area for years.

## **Schedule:**

Wednesday classes meet from 2:05 to 3:05 p.m.

Thursday classes meet from 3:15 to 4:15 p.m.

Classes begin on Wednesday, October 1, 2008 and Thursday, October 2, 2008.

Classes end on Wednesday, May 20, 2009 and Thursday, May 21, 2009.

## **Tuition:**

Tuition for the entire year is \$240 (approximately \$8 per hour-long session) for Mandarin, French and German. Tuition for Practical Arts Spanish Immersion is \$280 for the year which includes a \$40 materials fee. Payment is due at the time of registration. Families with more than one student enrolled in the Beye PTO World Languages Program may pay in two installments, with full payment due by November 21st. A limited number of scholarships are available; please contact Mr. Ellwanger for consideration.

## **Registration:**

Please complete the attached form and return it with payment to the school as soon as possible, but no later than **Sept. 10, 2008**. Registration is not considered complete until payment is received. Checks should be made out to "**Beye PTO World Languages Program**." You will be notified of your child's placement the week before classes begin.
